Targeted group:

- Making the conferences and courses to discuss the Palestinian children rights and conveying their voice to the right direction.

##### Women program:

Women program aim to promote and enhancing the women role in involving her in the social development process reach to decision making and leadership among the following:

### 1. Background of the project :

The Palestinian Youth are suffering from lack of civil education based on Democracy and Civilian society. This problem reflects negatively on their daily behaviors and attitudes in the different aspects of life.

It is evidently known that Israeli occupation distorted this civil awareness among youth because of the occupation-based policy followed by the Israeli occupation. The evolution of the national Authority didn't establish sufficient and solid base for reinforcing and encouraging civil society.

Youth People are considered to be the core unit that any society depends on for constructive change toward democracy, human rights and civil culture.

Therefore, we targeted the youth (18 -25 ) to implement this education, to equip them with the weapons which enable them to create healthy, civil and democratic society based on positive interaction and continuous creativity from one hand, and from the other hand eradicating violence chauvinism and fanaticism out of the Society.

### 2. Project Objectives and expected results :

1. Reinforce the concepts of democracy and human rights into the Youth awareness.
- 1- Change their attitudes toward the eventually build up healthy civil society.
- 2- Treat and modify the serious negative attitudes resulting from distorted awareness.
- 3- Encourage positive interaction among youth and emphasize mutual respect regardless of sex, and ideology.
- 4- Emphasize the significance of Democratic Dialogue as a basic for health relationship and conflict resolution.
- 5- Provide the youth with skills, knowledge and attitudes to enable them to work effectively with their local communities.

### 3. Project strategy, activities and implementation :

The project duration is 6 months divided as follow :

#### I. Preparation stage: (2 weeks).

#### II. Training stage ( 4 weeks )

- Duration of the course ( 100 training hours )
- No. of trainees are ( 20).
- Training will be 5 hrs. a day for 5 days weekly.

#### III. Lobbying and Advocacy Stage : ( 18 weeks )

- i. Conducting 10 community meetings, number of participants for each of which is about 30 persons and total of 120 participants
- ii. Conducting 6 workshops for teachers and educated people ,number of the participants for each of which are 20 and total of 120 participants



- iii. Organizing 8 cultural and recreational activities, 15 young people participate for each of which and total of 120 participants.
- iv. Organizing an 10 open dialogue sessions for youth, number of the participants for each of which are 25 and total of 250 of young people .

#### 4. Monitoring and evaluation procedures :

Our indicators for monitoring and evaluation will be the activities which are going to be implemented and the number of participants for each exactly as prescribed on project strategy and implementation .

#### 5. Sustainability :

After the initiative have been taken, the training is conducted, all the basis of the program is constructed and the major activities have been implemented, It will be easy for the organization to run and implement the program depending on the community participation and local resources.

#### 6. Financial assistance requested :

The requested assistance is 34500 \$ , the rest will be covered by the NGO.
