Context (1/2 page):

The current humanitarian emergency followed the outbreak of violence in September 2000 and is a result of restrictions on Palestinian freedom of movement, military operations, land confiscation and levelling and the construction of the Barrier. The Government of Israel (GoI) states that these measures were implemented to prevent militant attacks against its citizens.

A serious intensification of this situation is now possible following the victory of the Hamas party in the Palestinian Legislative council elections held in January 2006.

The GOI has stopped handing over to the PA VAT and customs taxes that it collects on Palestinian goods on its behalf. Recently however, the GoI has announced that it would use a proportion of this money to pay for electricity, water and fuel costs owed to Israeli companies. At the same time, Western donors signalled their intention to review their funding support to the PA – the nascent state structure they had supported with more than \$7 billion in aid since the Oslo Accords in 1993.

Unless this shortfall is made up on some other way, a functioning state apparatus risks being seriously undermined. Over 152,000 people are employed by the PA; their salaries support approximately one million people – or 25% of the Palestinian population. These people operate 62% of primary health clinics, all the major general hospitals bar one and 75% of primary and secondary schools.

Without PA salaries, poverty rates are predicted to increase sharply, conservatively, to 74%. Since 2000, poverty rates increased from 22% to 56%. Palestinian Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth is anticipated to drop to negative 25% in 2006 compared to 5% positive growth in 2005. At the same time the non-payment of 70,000 armed PA security personnel could lead to a highly volatile security situation and in turn to a possible rise in criminality. The level of insecurity will in large part determine the depth of the humanitarian crisis and could undermine the humanitarian response. And, while this is likely to be most acutely felt in the West Bank and Gaza Strip, if past patterns are any indication, the violence may also spill over and be directed at Israel, including the targeting of Israeli civilians.

Families have always been helpless against these situations, constantly seeking professional help for their children's needs which usually are unmet. This was clearly stated through letters and complaints which the society received from women at the local community asking for urgently intervention to overcome the increasingly problems among their sons all over the Area. To respond to this emerging situation, which highlighted the chronic lack in the mental health services even in normal circumstances, the secretariat of the national program of action for Palestinian children (NPA Secretariat) and in co-operation with many other organizations begin some emergency actions to coordinate effects, the NPA Secretariat organized a series of meeting with concerned agencies to discuss their actions and future plans. The outcome of these meetings indicated a need to formulate a mental health plan that would meet only the short term needs of this crisis situation, but would also focus on the long-term strategies of mental health in Palestine. As the next step, it was suggested to put in place a community mental health program targeting children and youth. Nuseirat one of Middle Zone refugees camps of the Gaza Strip, 20 Km² is one of the most densely populated regions of the Gaza Strip and very recently one of the most neglected areas of Palestinian territories. In 2002, the population of Nuseirat camp was estimated (51000) inhabitants according to Palestinian Bureau of Statistics: Of the total population some 49% are children under the age of 14 years, 55% under the age of 18 years. The population of the area as the same thing as the Gaza strip is youthful, probably due to high birth rate combined with low life expectancy at birth, both of which reflect the generally under developed health and socioeconomic conditions, of the total

population, roughly 85% were registered as refugees with the United Nation Relief and Work Agency UNRWA. Until the coming of the PNA in 1994, the Gaza strip and definitely the refugees' camps were seriously neglected of the services sector and the development programs, particularly in the field of mental health rehabilitation and community development services.

The targeted area:

The project will target the most effected areas by last occupation circumstances in the Middle zone beside the removed settlements neighbourhoods as the following:

El- Zawida village and surroundings, El Hekair & surroundings are rural areas, located at the southern part of Deir El Balah city near to Khanyounis city and until very recently, one of the most neglected and marginalized areas over the Gaza strip. It was lying closely to both Kefar Darom & Gush Qatef settlements and is in direct contact with Israeli military check points.

Al Mughraga Area & surrounding are rural, neglected areas also, located at the southern part of Gaza city near to Nusierat camp, in addition to the newly established El zahra city. These lie closely to Netzalem settlement and in direct contact with Israeli military check points also. Moreover, the eastern parts of both Buriej and El Mughazi refugees' camps which are close to the Green Line and many military check points. Which constantly expose the people to the previously mentioned aggression of the Israeli soldiers and settlers.

Description of the Problem (2 paragraphs):

The current situation increase the feeling of helplessness and victimization among the people there particularly children and youth. These traumatic experiences affected the children's basic functions wither mental, psychological and cognitive. Most reports to health centres emphasized the fact that children chief complaints have been night mares, nocturnal enuresis, aggressiveness, low achievement at schools, withdrawal are psychosomatic complaints. Families have always been helpless against these situations, constantly seeking professional help for their children's needs which usually are unmet. This was clearly stated through letters and complaints which the society received from women at the local community asking for urgently intervention to overcome the increasingly problems among their children all over the Areas.

Since the eruption of Al-Aqssa Intifada in Sep.,2000, the feeling of helplessness and victimization among Palestinian was increased particularly among youth and children. The traumatic experiences affected the youth's basic functions whether mental, psychological,

physiological and cognitive. Most reports to health centers emphasized the fact that their chief complaints have been nightmares, aggressiveness & violence, withdrawal and other psychosomatic complaints. Families have always been helpless against these situations, constantly seeking professional help which have been rarely met. Moreover the adolescence stage is considered the most critical one during life span, through which the children are more vulnerable. As a transitional period, it accompanies many of emotional and behavioral disorders and needs appropriate intervention

How the project will address the problem (2 paragraphs):

The project aim to improve the psychology, mentality ,personality & domestication for quick-tempered of the children victims of social & political violence by support healthy practices and capacity building programs for 200 children from the selected targets.

Objectives of the proposed project (how will the project achieve its aim?):

- Improving the psychology, mentality ,personality & domestication of quick-tempered, for 200 children victims of social & political violence.
- Taking part of reduction the intensity of emotionality reactions as resulting from the social & political violence that the children face by involving them at informal activities.
- Developing the hobbies & creative capacity for the targeted children.
- Securing the positive safety weather for the targeted children to be able practice the several projects activities.
- Developing the children reaction behaviours towards each other & their stakeholders.
- Building the capacity of the targeted groups to be able to express their selves.
- Raising the awareness of the families, school teachers & local community regards to psychological and social problems of children.
- Develop models that integrates promotion of these healthy practices.

Expected Results:

- 200 child will have a space to discuss their psycho social restraints and hardships
- Parents and teachers are sanitized about children psycho social hardships and are provided with some tools to deal with it through 5 awareness sessions.
- 15 children activists will build up their skills in peer counseling
- Self expression sessions will provide the opportunity to highlight youth deep feelings and resentments
- The fun days which held by youth for children will address psycho social issues in recreational settings.
- The sports tournaments are held hosting 200 children participating in athletic competitions
- Opportunities to exercise their hobbies and talents in music and singing will be possible in the DJ party.
- Children behavioural positive changing in additional to good mentality that will increase the children capacity of caring about their community and home
- Children will share the local community activities and sharing also in the community development.

- Community will be affected positively by the new ideas and good work in the bases in which the community bases were children in the future.
- Sustainability of the ideas in the community and by the adoption of these ideas by the people and by the stakeholder.
- Development of the economic situation for the families of employers in this project.
- More experience in facing like these problems among children in the future while our people were susceptible to like these situations.
- Community awareness increasing toward dealing with the victims children reactions.

Activities and Outputs:

Task One Title: Preparation, coordination, recruitment and orientation of the team (2 months and half)

Task Description:

- *Recruitment of the team (Advertisement-Interviewing-Selection of the team)
The team includes: (Project coordinator- 3Psycho social specialists- 15 Community activists , Secretary)*
- *Conducting all the necessary contacts & coordination with the local community organizations.*
- *Forming of an advisory committee from the relevant local community set ups.*
- *Forming of youth leaders groups.*
- *Conducting an orientation sessions for community activists.*
- *Conducting an orientation sessions for youth leaders.*
- *Conducting of 3 focus groups (Needs Assessment).*
- *Conducting of planning sessions for all the project activities.*
- *Writing the administrative & financial reports and submitting it to the donation agency.*

Task Two Title: Starting of the project activities. (6 months)

Task Description:

- *Meeting with the advisory committee.*
- *Conducting 3sectoral workshops & open discussion targeting the parents, teachers with attendance of youth leaders to discuss issues of children psychosocial health mainly daily kickback with other family members, fear ailment & nervous, dejection, sleepless& studying retardation. These workshops will provide parents& teachers with practical methods & tools for psychosocial understanding of children behavior and would promote the activities which the youth will provide mainly recreational and sports activities.*
- *Organizing an open dialogue with social workers, the audience will be the youth with their teachers & parents.*
- *Organizing 15 sessions for self expression facilitated by specialists and youth (3 sessions each area)*

- *Conducting 5 theater show sessions in 5 areas. the theater session is composed of 3 sketches on 3 basic themes.*
- *Conducting 10-15 fun days that is 2 to 3 fun day per each area, this fun-day include group of activities like cultural competition, folklore shows, theater plays. Parents, teachers, activists & children are invited on these days.*
- *Organizing 5 sports tournament, one for each area (Basket Ball – Ping pong- Chess- football)*
- *Implementing one DJ party as free day one on each area for the children self expression & give them a chance to present their hobbies in front of the audience.*

Task Three: Conducting the activities, Evaluation & reporting (1 month and half)

Task Description:

- *Organizing the final celebration of the project activities (500) participants will attend.*
- *Conducting an evaluation session for the project activities.*
- *Preparing and submitting the final report to the donation agency.*

Outcomes:

- 200 children aged 6-12 years will participate all psychological, mental & capacity building activities.
- 500 children from the main target groups closed relation will benefit from the entertainments activities such as (funny days, DJ parties, theater shows)
- 200 families will be benefited from the awareness sessions workshops targeted the parents, beside their benefit from attending the popular activities.
- 100 teachers will be benefit from the awareness workshops targeting them.
- Unassisted number of people will be benefited from the children Magazine which will produced among the project.

All the project beneficiaries will benefit of healthy snacks during the different sessions
